Arlington, Virginia – Today the Virginia Latino Leaders Council (VLLC), endorsed Terry McAuliffe for Governor, Hala Ayala for Lt. Governor and Mark Herring for Attorney General.

This announcement comes after the VLLC 2021 endorsement survey of hundreds of Latino leaders and activists yielded an overwhelming 93% support for all three Democratic candidates. VLLC's President, The Honorable J. Walter Tejada, stated, "Terry McAuliffe has been a good friend to the Latino community. He embraces diversity and stands for the issues that are important to our community. During his tenure as Governor, he fought for the expansion of health care, in-state tuition for immigrants and educational opportunities for all Virginians.
